Barral Institute Case Study Visceral Manipulation - Leg Pain Nancy Redlich, PT

Patient Age / Gender Male

Patient Symptoms

LBP and chronic disc symptoms - posterior thigh and hip pain, instability.

Evaluation / Treatment

Evaluation showed restrictions in pelvis/SI joints compressed. Significant lumbar mobility impairments and abdominal cavity organ restrictions throughout especially liver, colon, mesenteric roots of small intestines. Valves were all dysfunctional -> *1CV (greatest), poor motilities in kidneys and pelvic floor, organs.

Outcome

After initial treatment to liver, valves and mesenteric roots he had complete reduction of leg and posterior thigh pain.
